Thank you to everybody for responding so positively to the 'smart uniform' request. We are very proud of how the children are in school! A reminder is on the back of this flyer for our uniform if you are starting to think about next year! Please note, next year will be black SHOES only for school – trainers will no longer be permitted.

School Reports

The children's school reports for this year will all be emailed home on Friday July 9th2021. Unfortunately, it has not been possible to arrange any face-to-face parent meetings this year but if you should need to talk to your child's teacher, please phone the school and ask for them to you call back. This will usually be at the end of the school day.

Breakfast Club

I am delighted to tell you that Mrs Jay is the new Breakfast Club Supervisor. Breakfast Club will now reopen for all children. Please book through the school office if you require a place. The Club will now start from 7:30am and the children will be seen to their classes at 8:30am each day. The cost is £2 per child, per session. If your child is eligible for Pupil Premium, there is no cost for Breakfast Club.

School Gates

A huge thank you to Mrs Sharman, who has supported the school in campaigning for new, taller gates to replace our existing ones at the front drive to the school. This has been an ongoing saga but at last we are finally able to go ahead and hope to have the new gates installed in early September. This will further enhance the safety of all the children on our site.

Drinking Water

As the weather has finally changed and the days are much warmer, please could your child/ren bring a named drinking bottle of water to school every day. We are actively trying to encourage all children to drink water as they get very thirsty during the day and need to hydrate. Squash and fruit juice are **not** permitted in their drinking bottles.

Sun cream & Hats

With the warmer weather, children should bring a sun hat to school. We do provide additional shelter at play and sports times, as the playground and field have very little shade, but for extra protection a sunhat would be ideal. We do not provide sun cream but are happy for your children to bring this into school. Please make sure any creams are named and their teacher is aware. The children will be encouraged to apply this themselves with adult support if needed.
