# What happens when I come to nursery or school?



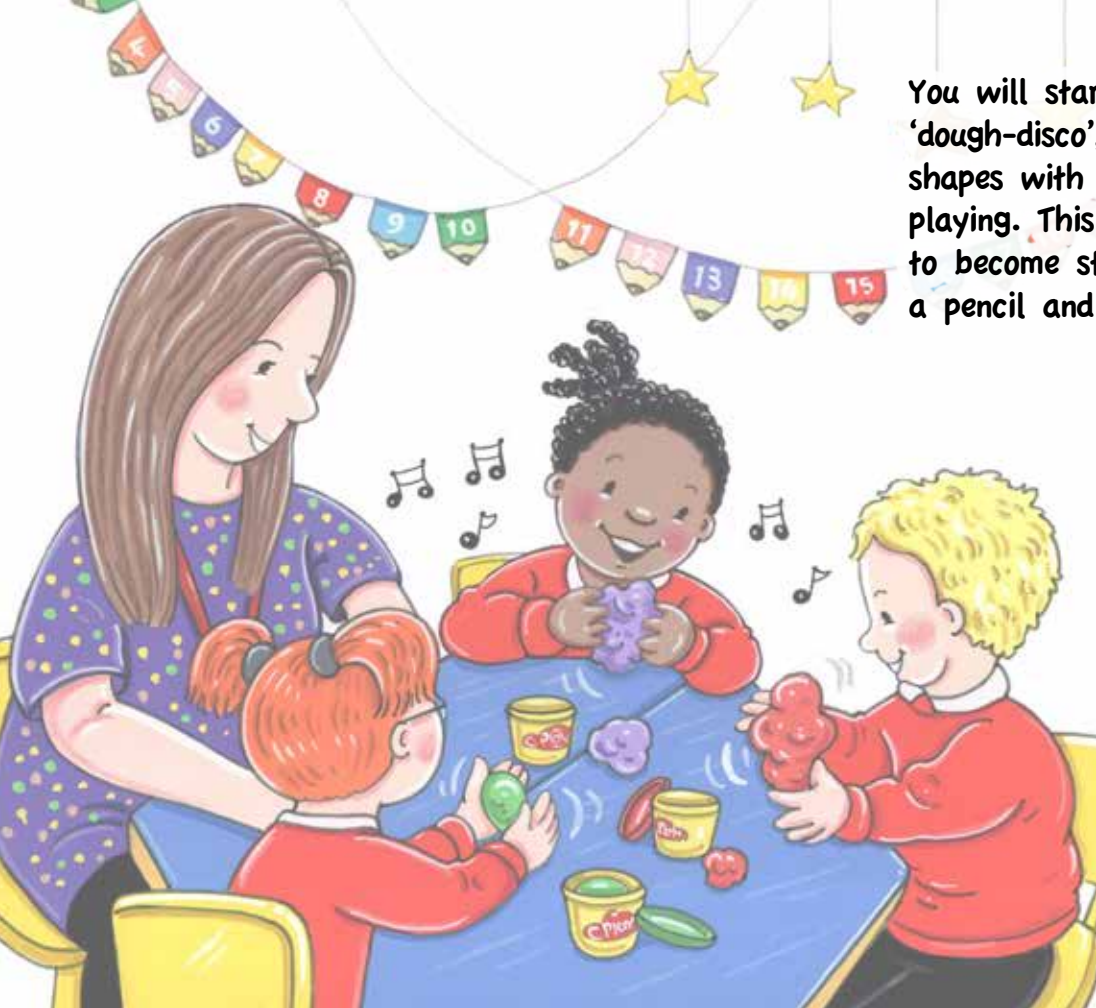
Your grown-ups bring you to the playground and drop you off outside the classroom. Your teacher will be waiting there to say “hello” and bring you into the classroom.

"What big eyes you have," says Natasha.



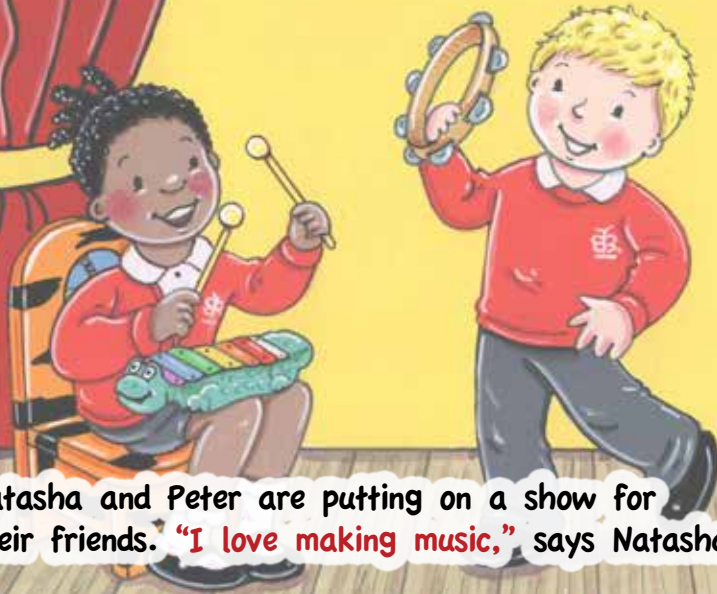
Outside there is a stage where you can play music or do some acting. There are places for water and sand play, a mud kitchen and a messy area.

# What if I am hungry or thirsty?

If you are staying for lunch, you will go to another room and sit at a table to eat with your friends. A kind adult will bring hot lunches to you at your table. They will look after you when you are eating.

**“Everything is the right height and size for me,”** says Rebecca.

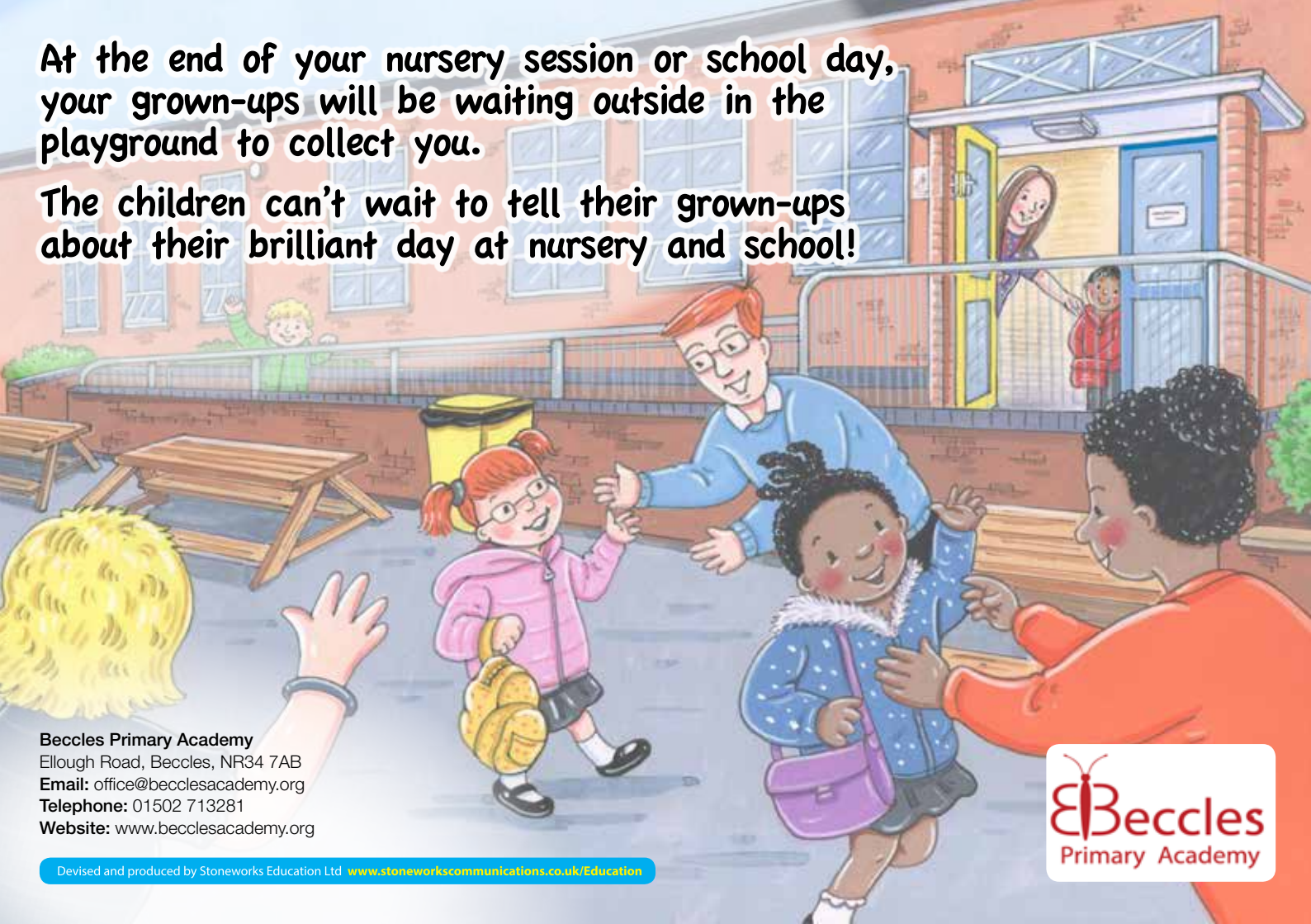
Rebecca practised going to the toilet by herself at home before she started school.
