

Maths

Multiplication and division: recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 2, 5 and 10 multiplication tables; calculate mathematical statements for multiplication and division; show that multiplication of two numbers can be done in any order (commutative) and division of one number by another cannot; solve problems involving multiplication and division.

Fractions: recognise, find, name and write fractions a length, shape, set of objects or quantity; write simple fractions.

Measurement: choose and use appropriate standard units to estimate and measure length/height; compare and order lengths, mass, volume/capacity; recognise and use symbols for pounds (£) and pence (p); combine amounts to make a particular value; find different combinations of coins that equal the same amounts of money; compare and sequence intervals of time; tell and write the time to five minutes and draw the hands on a clock face to show these times; know the number of minutes in an hour and the number of hours in a day.
